An historic village and chic resort, Megève nurtures the art of French living at an altitude of 1,100 metres. Nestled at the heart of the Mont Blanc massif, the village owes its reputation to the Rothschild family. A century ago, Baroness Noémie de Rothschild chose Megève to infuse with a level of prestige that reflected her own personality.

Megève is enhanced by its unspoiled architecture, with its many timeless farms lending its landscapes a rare authenticity. Built from natural materials, Megève's chalets are simply stunning and continue to attract a great many visitors.







# GETTING HERE, GETTING AROUND AND PARKING

### BY AIR

Geneva international airport is only an hour from Megève. Allow for a 2-hour drive from Lyon airport.

### BY TRAIN

The Sallanches high-speed train station is located 12 kilometres from Megève. From there, you can get easily to the resort, thanks to many frequent bus services.

### BY CAR

An extensive motorway network makes Megève easily reachable. From Paris for example, take the A6 and then the A40.

### PARKING IN MEGÈVE

### ON THE MEG'BUS NETWORK

Don't fancy clearing your car of snow every morning? A network of shuttlebuses runs daily in Megève. Every winter, the resort runs a free and semi-free shuttlebus service, providing a fast, easy way to get around. There's no need to worry about your car, the frequent buses are a hassle-free way to travel around the resort from morning to night.

With four bus lines, the entire resort and its hamlets are well-served. Rochebrune, Mont d'Arbois, Côte 2000, Chataz, Princesse and Combloux are all accessible thanks to the shuttlebuses.

If you choose this mode of transport, you can leave your car in one of the town's underground car parks. To save time and make life easier, you can also pre-book online at the Megéve car park website.

A little tip Follow the Meg'Bus network transport in real time with the Pysae app!



Seven main car parks are available in the resort of Megève. Four of them are under cover and three are located outside, in the open air. When you book with Cimalpes, our teams will let you know the process for booking a parking space so that you can enjoy your stay with total peace of mind.

Or you could rent accommodation that comes with a garage or a parking space. Though almost impossible with hotels or apartments, parking spaces are often included if you choose to rent a chalet with Cimalpes.

Blue disc or parking meter permits, which are available in Megève village, are another option. Perfect if you take a little unplanned shopping trip!

### WHAT ABOUT ELECTRIC CARS?

Electric vehicle charging points are available for your use:

- two charge points on the Route Nationale, in front of the playground.
- two charge points in the Beausoleil car park.
- one charge point at the Casino car park.
