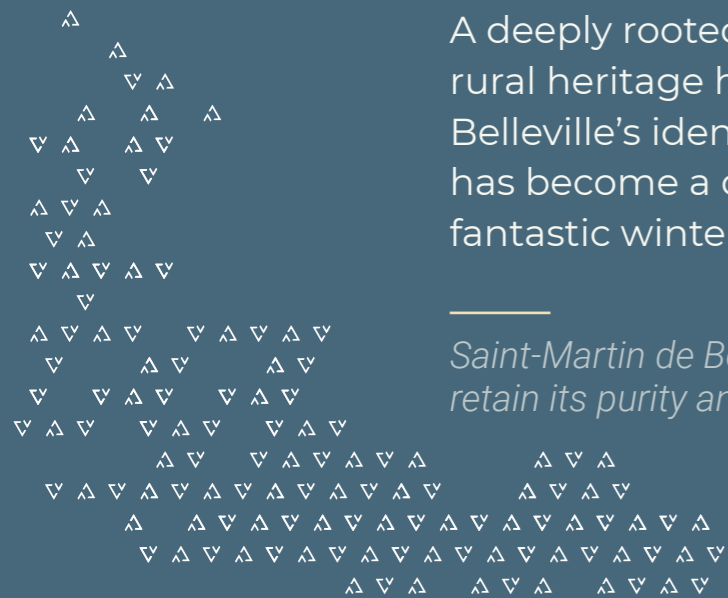

The authentic village of Saint-Martin de Belleville is the only 3 Vallées resort to have existed before skiing. Its pretty little cobbled streets, wood, stone and slate chalets and vaulted barns await you. The village's elegant charm won't fail to enchant you.

GETTING HERE, GETTING AROUND AND PARKING

Saint-Martin de Belleville is also the closest resort to large urban areas. Just 12 minutes from Les Menuires and Méribel (on the St Martin and St Martin Express ski lifts), and 25 minutes from Val Thorens, Saint-Martin de Belleville occupies a prime location.

BY AIR

The resort is accessible from numerous airports. Geneva international airport is a 2 hour 30 minute journey from Saint Martin. Lyon airport is just 2 hours from the resort. The closest airport is Chambéry, just one hour and 15 minutes away.

BY TRAIN

The nearest train station is Moûtiers, which is around 20 kilometres from Saint-Martin-de-Belleville. There are three different ways to get to the village from the station:

- Rental car
- Bus/Coach. The many regular transfers offer an easy, fast way to reach the resort.
- Taxi

BY CAR

Several motorways offer a hassle-free route into Saint-Martin de Belleville. Exiting the motorway at Moûtiers for example, you're just 20 kilometres from the resort.

GETTING AROUND IN SAINT-MARTIN DE BELLEVILLE

SHUTTLEBUS

It's easy to get around Saint-Martin de Belleville resort without a car, and to get from there to other neighbouring villages. A network of free shuttlebuses will take you to Val Thorens via Les Ménuires, for example.

Most shuttlebus services run 7 days a week. They also connect Saint-Martin to Villarabout and serve the following destinations: Les Places, La Mairie, Le Cochet, Les Chapelles, Le Château Feuillet and La Villette.

PARKING IN SAINT-MARTIN DE BELLEVILLE

There is plenty of parking here: close to the shops, parking spaces are regulated by blue zones limited to 1 hour 30 minutes, there are also spaces opposite the Townhall and La Voûte restaurant, as well as alongside Le Biolley building. You can pick up a permit free of charge from the Saint-Martin-de-Belleville Tourist Centre. Additionally, parking is free in the Le Cochet, La Duche and Château Feuillet car parks.
