

SNOW WHITE MOUNTAINS.... ... AWAIT YOU


The resort of Tignes is set on a vast, snowcovered plateau surrounded by majestic summits. The village offers holidaymakers a chance to unwind, in an unspoiled setting.



The resort is divided into four districts, each with their own distinctive characteristics. Wherever you are, the ski lifts make the ski area accessible from all over the resort. From lively streets to sunny terraces, via the magic of the mountains, Tignes combines all these features to give you a precious, immersive stay.







GETTING HERE, GETTING AROUND AND PARKING

BY AIR

Tignes enjoys a prime location. The resort is located between four different airports, from which you can continue your journey to the resort in under 3 hours by car.

- Genève Cointrin airport
- Grenoble airport
- Chambéry Savoie Mont-Blanc airport
- Lyon Saint-Exupéry airport

Frequent transfers are available between the airports and the resort.

BY TRAIN

Tignes is a highly accessible ski resort by train. The closest station is Bourg-Saint-Maurice, which is located around 40 minutes from Tignes by bus or taxi. From Paris, a direct line will take you to Bourg-Saint-Maurice in just 4 hours, making your journey a lot easier. 30 kilometres from the resort, major lines run to the train station daily.

BY CAR

To get to Tignes by car, follow the A430 from Chambéry to Albertville, then continue to Moûtiers. Next, the route nationale A road to Bourg-Saint-Maurice will connect you with the B-road up to Tignes.

Your Satnav may direct you towards the Col du Petit Saint-Bernard or the Col de l'Iseran. Please be aware that both of these mountain passes are closed throughout winter.

GETTING AROUND IN TIGNES

SHUTTLEBUSES

Free inter-resort shuttlebuses run throughout the winter season in Tignes, with the resort making a special point of limiting short car journeys as far as possible. Tignes is a resort that lives and breathes. There are several shuttlebus routes in the resort: Val Claret - Lavachet Lac - Tignes 1800. They run approximately every fifteen minutes, between 7am and 8pm. After that, the night bus lines take over.

PARKING IN TIGNES

We strongly recommend that you leave your car in a car park for the entirety of your stay. Free shuttlebuses run 24 hours a day and are a very convenient way to get around the resort. Drop-off points are available close to accommodation to make it easy to unpack and get settled in.

Most of the covered car parks offer a set rate of 19€ a night and 93€ per week.


Le Rosset "premium" car park costs 22€ a night and 110€ per week. Its spaces are wider with a higher roof, and the car park was built very recently.

If you're staying for over five days and are arriving and leaving on either a Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, we strongly recommend that you book your parking space in advance. Covered car parks incur a charge between November 27th 2021 and May 1st 2022

A 360° view at altitudes of more than 3,000 metres? That's what Le Panoramic restaurant offers. This Michelin-starred restaurant is an unmissable destination during your stay in Tignes. Accessible on skis and on foot thanks to the Grande Motte funicular lift, Le Panoramic stands out due to its prestigious position facing Mont Blanc. The cuisine is natural and gourmet and many of the dishes are cooked on woodfire embers. More than just a Michelin-starred restaurant, it combines three different atmospheres: a gastronomic dining establishment, a self-service and a takeaway snack area.
