
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## GETTING HERE, GETTING AROUND AND PARKING



Many trains and major high-speed train lines stop at Bourg-Saint-Maurice train station, which, at just 40 minutes by car, is the closest station to Val d'Isère. The Altibus transport group runs transfers from the train station.

BY CAR

Car access is via the A43 motorway to Albertville. At the exit, take the n° 90 dual carriageway to Moûtiers. Then, head to Bourg-Saint-Maurice and finally, Val d'Isère. It's well worth the journey!

### **SHUTTLEBUSES**

Every season, the resort runs a network of free shuttlebuses. They offer an easy way to get from one end of Val d'Isère to the other. Three bus lines (red, blue and yellow) serve the entirety of the resort's hamlets: La Daille, the centre, Le Laisinant, Chatelard, Joseray and Le Fornet. Le Legettax hamlet is also accessible by shuttlebus.

On the red line, every stop is marked with a sign. They display the direction the shuttlebus is going, as well as a bus network map. Additionally, when you're waiting at a stop, you'll be kept informed in real time about when the next bus is expected to arrive.
